### Scholastic Activities:

1. **Innovation Hub Visit:** 14 teachers of Science, Computer, Art & Craft visited Innovation Hub on 06 July 2017. They visited Resource Centre, Discovery Hall, Sound Studio, Design Studio, 3D Digital Art Studio, Electronics Zone, Tor-Phod-Jod Lab., Break n Remake Lab., Kabaad se Jugaad Lab., Clay and fibre work Studio, Green House and Bonsai. Later, the teachers interacted with The Director, BSM.
2. **“JIGYASA” 2017:** A Summer Science Research Camp was organised on 07<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> July 2017 at CSIR, CEERI Pilani. 51 students of BSV registered for the camp out of which 20 were selected. Finally, 18 students participated in the camp. On 07 July 2017 Prof. Shantanu Chaudhury, The Director CEERI, Prof. S. Pal, Prof. Raj Singh were present at the inauguration. Prof. K. J. Rangra conducted a session on Electro mechanical devices and systems followed by a lecture on Microwave devices and systems by Prof. A. Bandyopadhyay. Thereafter, the students visited Electron microscope Lab. Microwave tube division, Work shop, Electronic control systems Lab. and Signal analytic group. On 08 July 2017 two lecture session were conducted by Prof. S. Pal on evolution of lighting technology in which he described how lighting devices changed from electric bulb to LED and Journey of Computers over the time by Prof. P. Tanwar. Selected students of Birla Shishu Vihar gave PPT presentation on different topics viz. NIPPERS (slippers with navigation system) by Udit, Rahul and Adi, Next generation space craft by Nisha, Detection of earthquake using electromagnetic waves by Ananya, Mind to mind communication by Ayan and Arun, Device that can talk to animals and trolley with sensors by Sheetal, Diksha, Jigyasa and Gargi and Time machine by Rudrakshi. Also, six selected posters prepared by our students were displayed.
