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

Situation of Ground Water in Rajasthan

Ground water is the vital source of water for many tube wells, stepwells handpumps, wells etc The proportion of water in Rajasthan is relatively minor than other states. In this state 215 of 284 dams are shriveled and remaining 69 have stubby levels of water. The 22 massive dams in the state, 9 of them have no water. Corona lockdown causes great crisis of water in Rajasthan. It influenes the economy of the state. The fact that underground water is depleting fast and its quality is deteriorating through the mixage of sewage by industries.

The levels of ground water is decreasing because the harmful materials thrown in fresh body, are not overlooked chemicals such as lead and mercury. We should be aware and take precautions that, not to pollute ground water more.

These freshwater lakes are decreasing because a massive amount of wastewater or sewage is dumped into water bodies such as lakes, ponds which pollutes their fresh water and make it inappropriate for any kind of consumption due to the rise of several bacteria.
