SKILL FEST 2024-25 : A CELEBRATION OF TALENT

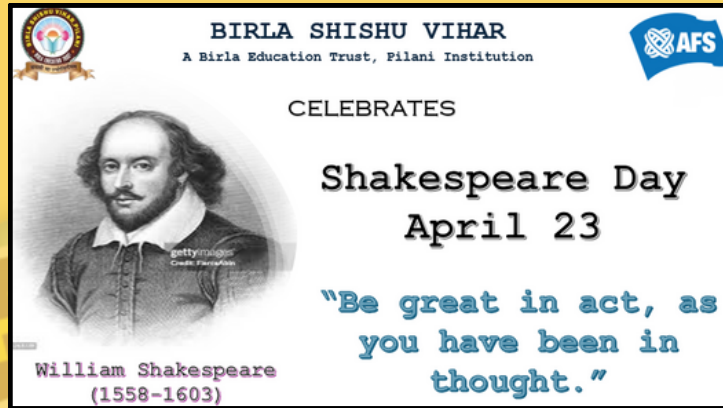
