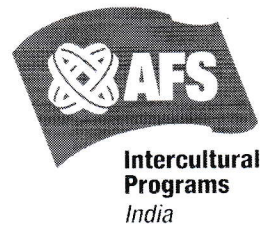

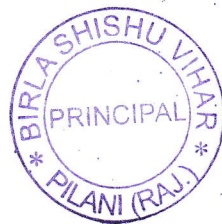

PROHIBITION OF CORPORAL PUNISHMENT

1. Corporal punishment is a form of physical punishment that involves the deliberate infliction of pain as retribution for an offence, or for the purpose of disciplining or reforming a wrongdoer, or to deter attitudes or behavior deemed unacceptable.
2. Time and again, I would like to remind you that Corporal Punishment to the students in all forms by any staff members is strictly forbidden, moreover, it is against the code of school. The concept of punishment has always nursed a sense of fear and learning does not occur in a fear prone environment. It is, therefore, imperative that teachers should adopt such methods by which the student develops a sense of self-confidence and self-dependence. On certain occasions, when the behavior and attitude of the students have not been acceptable, it is important to find out the reasons for such errant behavior and counsel them appropriately rather than to punish them straight away. This kind of practice is now outdated and subjected to resist by the psychologists and counselors as well with the changing world wide scenario in dealing with children of new generation.
3. There is no scope for such punishments in the learning environment and the teachers should adopt strategies by which the learner realizes one's mistake. Counseling at different levels is the best method to motivate the problematic children. Love reinforces confidence and once the student believes that the school atmosphere is permeating with love from the teachers, they will desist from indulging any acts that would negate the environment that has been built.
4. It is, therefore, requested that the teachers should bring home the above points and ensure that no child is subjected to any corporal punishment at any point of time in the schooling process. Corporal punishments are therefore to be avoided at any cost in the school.
5. Please comply with the above points strictly without fail.
