Subject: Academic Advisory for Class XI – Role of Subject Teachers

All Subject Teachers handling Class XI are hereby advised to take note of the following academic priorities and responsibilities:

1. Student Retention after Class X:

It is essential to maintain strong engagement with our students transitioning from Class X to XI. Your role in motivating, mentoring, and guiding them will significantly contribute to retaining students within the institution.

2. Conceptual Clarity and Application-Based Learning:

From the very beginning of the session, emphasis must be laid on building strong conceptual understanding. Teaching should go beyond rote learning and focus on application, analytical thinking, and problem-solving skills.

3. Importance of Practical Classes:

Practical sessions in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology are integral to effective learning. These must be conducted regularly, with proper planning and student involvement to strengthen theoretical concepts through hands-on experience. Teacher's presence during these classes is a must.

4. Consistency in Academic Performance:

All students of Class XI have been part of the school for several years and have performed well in their Class X Board Examinations. A decline in performance at this stage is neither expected nor acceptable. Teachers must ensure continuity in academic excellence.

5. Regular Monitoring and Responsibility:

Continuous assessment and close monitoring of each student's academic progress is the sole responsibility of the subject teacher. Timely feedback, remedial support, and individual attention should be provided wherever required.

6. Syllabus Coverage:

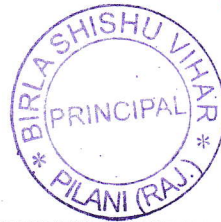
The syllabus must be covered in a structured and timely manner, ensuring adequate time for revision, practice, and assessment.
