Teaching Pedagogies

- iv. Planning of lesson and its implementation in class must be aligned with NCF at each level. Correction of students' work -feedback for improvement AND Informal/formal assessment of students on a regular basis- child's progress is to be maintained.
- v. Competency/skill development of students using various tools/pedagogies by the subject/mother teacher.
- vi. Use of Extraamarks content, digital tools, and virtual labs to assure concept building, live demo, learning process interesting/enjoyable.
- vii. Identification of bright & average students and work on them for further improvement. Measure the progress/regress of the child at regular intervals and act accordingly. Remedial measure.
- viii. Students' assessment aligned with learning Goals (LG) for each lesson /topic at each level- emerging trends of assessment tools.
- ix. Each subject teacher and compartment head is responsible for the compliance of mandatory instructions /guidelines, subject specific, issued by CBSE. The queries raised by students/parents are to be answered correctly. Ex. 3- language formula, addition/deletion of lesson(s)/topics, assessment reforms etc.

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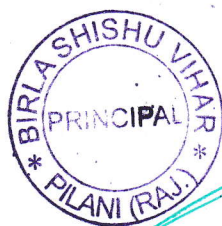
Cocurricular Activities, Skill Education & Sports
